This cute and simple mini amigurumi fish keychain is perfect for beginners! Follow the step-by-step guide and create your own colorful little fish to hang on your keys, bag, or gift to a friend.

Materials Needed:

- Cotton yarn (2-3 colors)
- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Keychain ring
- Stitch marker
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Optional: safety eyes or embroidery thread

Abbreviations (US Crochet Terms):

- MR Magic Ring
- sc Single Crochet
- inc Increase (2 sc in one stitch)
- dec Decrease (sc two together)
- sl st Slip Stitch
- ch Chain

Pattern

Fish Body:

- Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6)
- Rnd 2: inc around (12)
- Rnd 3: (sc, inc) x6 (18)
- Rnd 4-6: sc in each st (18)
- Rnd 7: (sc, dec) x6 (12)
- Rnd 8: dec x6 (6)
- Stuff firmly and close the opening.

Tail:

- Ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and across (4)
- Ch 1, turn, sc across (4)
- Make 2 pieces and sew them together for a fuller tail.

Assembly:

- 1. Attach the tail to the closed end of the body.
- 2. Sew on eyes (use safety eyes or embroider them with thread).
- 3. Attach the keychain ring securely on top of the fish's head.

Usage Warnings:

- This keychain is not suitable for children under 3 years old due to small parts.
- Always ensure safety eyes are securely fastened or opt for embroidered eyes for younger recipients.
- Do not machine wash. Clean gently with a damp cloth if needed.
